NETS 4WD4KIDS is a charity fundraising event designed to take 4WD owners, their families and friends on a 4WD adventure.

The event will take you to out of the ordinary places and gives you the opportunity to gain 4WD experience with the security of having an experienced support team travelling by your side.

4WD4KIDS is a three-day event where we travel no further than a couple of hours away from Sydney. We travel to our accommodation where we base ourselves for two nights. The event has something for everyone with a great mix of dirt roads and plenty of activities organised to keep the kids entertained.

The event raises funds for NETS, the NSW Newborn & Paediatric Emergency Transport Service. They are a statewide emergency service co-ordinating the medical retrieval of critically ill newborns, infants and children in NSW. NETS is contacted when a baby or child needs intensive care and this form of treatment is not available at their local hospital. A specialist team is sent out to transport the child either by a special NETS ambulance, the Child Flight helicopter or other aircraft.

Vehicles

The event is open to all road registered 4WD, AWD, SUV or suitable 2-wheel drive cars. Vehicles must be covered by **at least** third party PROPERTY insurance.

Drivers

Drivers must have a current Australian Drivers Licence.

Children

This is a family friendly event, children are welcome to come along.

Meals

All meals are catered throughout the event for which each person will need to purchase a meal ticket.



Accommodation

Accommodation may be included in the meal ticket on some events, otherwise accommodation options will be advised.

Entry Donation

The minimum entry donation is \$2000 per vehicle. The donation is fully tax deductible and 100% of all donations go to NETS. All donation cheques must be made payable to NETS. You can also build your own web site and fundraise online.

Route

The route changes with each event and participants will be given detailed route notes to follow at the morning and lunchtime checkpoints to lead them to the lunch or overnight stop.

Fuel

Diesel and Unleaded fuel is readily available. LPG is not always available but entrants will be notified of nearest availability.

Tyres

While we do advise to have the correct off road tyres fitted to your vehicle, most standard 4WD and SUV tyres will be suitable providing that they have better than 50% tread.



Support Crew

We have several plans in place to ensure the safety of our entrants. Travelling with the event will be:

- Experienced support crew performing set up, sweep and checkpoint duties
- Tyre and mechanical support vehicles including vehicle recovery equipment
- Medical support (doctor travelling with the event)
- Communications including UHF Radio's and Satellite Phones and HF radio including Base if required.
